RESOLUTION NO. 005-2020

POLICY GUIDELINES AND RECOMMENDATIONS RELATIVE TO THE MANAGEMENT OF THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) IN REGION 12

June 3, 2020

- **WHEREAS,** On May 22, 2020, the IATF issued and published amended Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the Community Quarantine in the Philippines;
- WHEREAS, Section 5, Item 2 of the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the Community Quarantine in the Philippines provides that "all persons shall now be allowed to go outside their residences";
- WHEREAS, in response to the call of President Rodrigo RoaDuterte to send returning OFWs back to their provinces, the Department of Transportation joins the National Task Force for COVID-19, and concerned government agencies, in establishing the 'HatidProbinsyaProgram, to assist and transport our stranded OFWs in Metro Manila back to their respective provinces;
- WHEREAS, On May 8, 2020, the IATF approved the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP), and the date of the school opening for SY 2020-2021 is determined to be on August 24, 2020 pursuant to DepEd Order No. 007 s. 2020. Essential points of the BE-LCP includes the following:
 - a) Opening of classes for the basic education shall be on 24 August 2020 and ending on 30 April 2021;
 - b) Opening of private schools will be allowed within the period provided by law. Provided thatschool learning continuity plan shall be submitted; no face-to-face classes will be allowed earlier than August 24, 2020; and, face-to-face learning shall only be allowed when the local risk severity grading permits, and subject to compliance with minimum health standards;

- c) Adoption of various learning delivery options such as but not limited to face-to-face, blended learnings, distance learnings, and homeschooling and other modes of delivery shall be implemented depending on the local COVID Risk Severity Classification and compliance with minimum health standards; and
- d) Conduct of curricular and co-curricular activities involving gatherings such as science fairs, showcase of portfolios, trade fairs, school sports, campus journalism, festival of talents, job fairs, and other similar activities is cancelled, except those conducted online.
- WHEREAS, the DICT's "Free Wi-Fi for All" aims to accelerate the Philippine government's efforts in enhancing internet accessibility for Filipinos so that, in turn, economic, social, and educational opportunities will be bolstered, and the growing Digital Divide can be bridged. The Project provides 40 megabits per second internet connectivity to remote areas and public places across the country. Also, during the Coronavirus Pandemic, the DICT offered "Free Wifi for All" at COVID-19 Accredited Testing Centers;
- WHEREAS, as a General Policy, all policies issued by the LGUs related to COVID-19 implementation should be aligned to IATF Omnibus Guidelines in the implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines issued last May 22, 2020 and other national government agencies' guidelines;
- WHEREAS, during the 69th Regular RDC Meeting, the Council approved and adopted a total of 49 Resolutions. Five (5) of the Resolutions (Resolutions No. 15, 16, 17, 19 and 21) were recommended for endorsement to the RIATF-EID XII for adoption;
- WHEREAS, one of the emerging concerns of the LGUs and NGAs in the region is the absence of RT-PCR test for Locally-Stranded Individuals (LSIs) returning to the different parts of Region XII;
- WHEREAS, upon thorough deliberation, the RIATF-EID XII member agencies deemed it necessary to appeal for the IATF-EID's consideration of Item 2 Section 5 of Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of the Community Quarantine in the Philippines which allowsall persons to go outside their residencesbut instead to restrict minors, senior citizens and those with co-morbidities that are going out for non-essential transactions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the RIATF-EID XII approves the following Resolutions:

1. RESOLUTION APPEALING FOR IATF-EID'S CONSIDERATION OF ITEM 2 SECTION 5 OF OMNIBUS GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE PHILIPPINES WHICHG ALLOWS ALL PERSONS TO GO OUTSIDE THEIR

- RESIDENCES BUT INSTEAD TO RESTRICT MINORS, SENIOR CITIZENS AND THOSE WITH CO-MORBIDITIES THAT ARE GOING OUT FOR NON-ESSENTIAL TRANSACTIONS
- 2. RESOLUTION REQUESTING ALL RESIDENTS OF REGION 12 TO REFRAIN FROM GONG OUTSIDE THEIR RESIDENCES EXCEPT ONLY FOR ESSENTIAL TRANSACTIONS (PURSUANT TO SECTION 5, ITEM 2 OF IATF OMNIBUS GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN THE PHILIPPINES);
- 3. RESOLUTION URGING LGUS OF REGION 12 TO ACT ON THE CONCERNS IN RELATION TO THE RESUMPTION OF COMMERCIAL FLIGHTS FROM MANILA AND OTHER POINTS OF DEPARTURE TO GENERAL SANTOS CITY;
- 4. RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE HATID-PROBINSYA PROGRAM OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT AND ENJOINING LGUs TO DEVISE MECHANISMS ON HOW TO BETTER IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM;
- 5. RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE DEPED'S CONTINUITY PLAN AND ENJOINING LGUS THROUGH THEIR LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS, LCPCS, AND SKS TO SUPPORT THE SAME;
- 6. RESOLUTION ENJOINING DICT AND THE PRIVATE TELCOS TO PROVIDE FREE WIFI TO FARFLUNG AREAS IN SUPPORT TO DEPED'S AND TESDA'S DISTANCE LEARNING PROGRAM;
- 7. RESOLUTION ENJOINING DICT AND OTHER TELECOMMUNICATION COMPANIES TO PROVIDE FREE INTERNET ACCESS ESPECIALLY TO FAR-FLUNG AREAS, FOR NGAS' WEBINARS, TELECONFERENCE AND THE LIKE;
- 8. RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FOLLOWING:
 - 8.1 RDC XII RESOLUTION NO.15 SERIES OF 2020 RE ENJOINING ALL LGUS TO CONSIDER AND ALIGN THEIR RESPECTIVE NEW NORMAL PLANS WITH THE GUIDELINES OF THE REGIONAL IATF;

- 12.8 OCD to join the TWG Meeting on ROFs and LSIs on June 4, 2020 and todiscuss the concern about LSIs coming in to the Region but are part of the neighboring regions; and
- 12.9 To seek guidance/clarification from IATF whether cockfighting operations will be allowed.
- **RESOLVED FURTHER,** that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the National Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-EID), National Task Force on COVID-19 for their appropriate action. The same copy to be furnished to the members of the RIATF-EID XII & RTF COVID-19, and LCEs of Region 12 for their information.
