SUBJECT : EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL AWARDS FOR THE CHILD-FRIENDLY MUNICIPALITIES AND CITIES

DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2006-19 issued on February 24, 2006 encourages all Local Government Units (LGUs) to join and support the 2006 Presidential Awards for the Child-Friendly Municipalities and Cities. The Awards system recognizes the vital role of the LGUs in promoting and protecting children's rights to survival, development, protection and participation and aims to strengthen the vital role of children in community life and nation building.

Please be informed that the National Awards Committee has extended the deadline for the submission of Entry Forms for the Presidential Awards to May 15, 2006. Interested Highly Urbanized Cities (HUCs) must submit their duly accomplished Entry Forms to the Regional Committee/Sub-Committee for the Welfare of Children (RC/SCWC) based at the Regional Offices of the DSWD.

For Municipalities and Component Cities (CCs), Entry Forms must be submitted to the Search Provincial Technical Working Group (PTWG) through the Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office (SWDO). Entry Forms are available at the Regional SWDO for HUCs and Provincial SWDO for municipalities and component cities.

DILG MC No. 2006-19 is hereby amended in so far as the deadline for submission of entries by LGUs is concerned. All DILG Regional Directors and field officers are hereby directed to cause the widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular and coordinate with the concerned Local Chief Executives in their area of jurisdiction.
