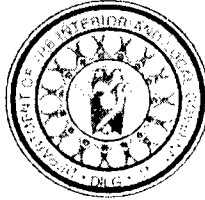


SUBJECT : IMPLEMENTATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 305 S. 2004

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 305, titled, *DEVOLVING TO MUNICIPAL AND CITY GOVERNMENTS THE REGISTRATION OF FISHING VESSELS THREE (3) GROSS TONNAGE AND BELOW*, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, particularly Section 13.2 thereof, all City and Municipal Local Chief Executives and Sanggunian Members are hereby reminded of the mandate, as they are hereby enjoined, to enact an ordinance to implement the aforementioned EO No. 305 and/or revise existing fishery or any related ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of the same EO No. 305 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

Relative thereto, the League of Cities of the Philippines and the League of Municipalities of the Philippines are hereby encouraged to disseminate to all their members copies of EO No. 305, its Implementing Rules and Regulations and, if possible, a model ordinance that will serve as a guide in enacting such an ordinance. The LCP and the LMP are likewise requested to submit to this Office a progress report on the implementation of EO No. 305 by their respective members.

All DILG Regional Directors are hereby directed to cause the immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular to all cities and municipalities within their regional assignments.
