OBSERVANCE OF THE 150TH BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF LEON APACIBLE

On October 25, 2011, the nation observes the 150th birth anniversary of Leon Apacible. Leon Apacible, a lawyer and a public servant, served as a Judge of the Court of First Instance of Batangas City. During the period of resistance against the colonial government, he became a member of General Miguel Malvar's forces, and in 1898, commanded his own forces in Batangas.

In this connection, all local chief executives are enjoined to extend their full support in this event by conducting activities of their own. The following activities, among others, may be undertaken on the week of the said event:

- Hosting an inspiring talk on the life and heroism of Leon Apacible;
