**CELEBRATING NATIONAL VOLUNTEER MONTH IN DECEMBER** 

In recognizing the volunteers and their contributions to society, Presidential Proclamation No. 194 dated 7 December 1987 declared every December 5 as International Volunteer Day (IVD) for Economic and Social Development in the Philippines. This is strengthened by Presidential Proclamation No. 55 issued on 5 December 1998, mandating the celebration of National Volunteer Month in December every year under the auspices of the Philippine National Volunteer Service Coordinating Agency (PNVSCA).

## The NVM aims to:

- Build nationwide public awareness and appreciation of volunteerism and the role it plays in the social, economic and political development of the country;
- Create the environment for bolstering voluntary action in development; and
- Recognize the noble acts of volunteerism by individuals families, institutions and communities as vital partners in economic and community development.

- Organizing or participating in volunteer-related activities;
