**TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY AND MUNICIPAL MAYORS
OF DAVAO REGION (REGION XI)**

**SUBJECT : ATTENDANCE TO THE WORKSHOP ON ACCESSING CLIMATE
FINANCE**

The Climate Change Commission (CCC), through its Green Climate Fund (GCF) Readiness Program for the Philippines in partnership with the United Nations Environment Program (UNEP) Economy Division (ED) and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) in support of its Public-Private Partnership Initiative for Local Governments (LGU P4) Program will conduct a one-day workshop entitled "Workshop on Accessing Climate Finance" on November 29, 2016 in Apo View Hotel, Davao City.

The workshop will include presentation and consultation with the stakeholders on the potential strategic investment interventions (road map) for a low carbon and climate resilient development pathway for the DILG PPP Program; PPP models (financial structures) and best practices on how to develop climate compatible PPP projects through a combination of available local financing resources; and proposed innovative ideas that will mitigate the risk the impacts of climate change and variability at the LGU/SME and PPP levels.

Meals during the activity will be provided by the organizer but travelling expenses and other incidental expenses related to the activity will be shouldered by the LGUs chargeable against local funds subject to the availability thereof and usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations and other pertinent laws, provided that the said expenses shall not be charged against the 20% component of the Internal Revenue Allotment or from whatever source that may prejudice on-going poverty alleviation efforts.


