PEACEFUL AND SAFE OBSERVANCE OF UNDAS 2017

Memorandum Circular No. 2017-145

October 30, 2017

1.0 Background

It is imperative to ensure that the forthcoming Undas 2017 is observed peacefully and safely, considering the immense number of people that will travel to and from different regions in the country.

2.0 Purpose

The purpose of the Circular is to enjoin LGUs to support the 2017 Peaceful and Safe Observance of Undas.

3.0 Scope/Coverage

All Provincial Governors, City and Municipal Mayors, DILG Regional Directors, ARMM Regional Governor, and all others concerned.

4.0 Policy Content and Guidelines

4.1 All Local Chief Executives are hereby directed to:

1. Convene the Local Peace and Order Council to formulate a contingency plan on peace and order, and public safety;
2. Cause the mobilization and deployment of law enforcers, barangay tanods, and medical personnel in:
 - a. The vicinity of public and private cemeteries and memorial parks to ensure peace and order and public safety;
 - b. Local and national roads to provide assistance and intensify visibility to the travelling public and motorist, and intensify effective traffic management; and
 - c. Critical areas within the Province, City and Municipality to prevent the entry and exit of lawless elements and to apprehend individual/s violating rules to ensure safe observance of Undas 2017;
3. Maintain the cleanliness and orderliness in cemeteries and other public places before, during and after Undas 2017; and
4. Implement other necessary measures towards a peaceful and meaningful observance of Undas 2017.


