SUBJECT : PARTICIPATION TO THE “RESILIENCE MARKETPLACE FOR INNOVATION FORUM”

As the lead agency for Disaster Preparedness, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), through the Local Government Academy (LGA) and in collaboration with development partners, will hold the **“Resilience Marketplace for Innovation Forum”** on **August 23, 2018 (Thursday), 8 AM – 6 PM**, at the **SMX Convention Center, Pasay City**.
