SUBJECT : 2018 OUTSTANDING FILIPINOS – AWARD FOR POLICE OFFICERS BY THE METROBANK FOUNDATION

The Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos is a career recognition award that is focused on teachers, soldiers, and police officers, who are: (a) ordinary Filipinos of extraordinary worth, (b) recognized models of excellence in the profession, (c) stand shoulder-to-shoulder with their global peers, (d) demonstrate the Filipino values of patriotism, integrity, courage and social responsibility, (e) thrive amidst adverse circumstances and triumphed over professional and personal challenges with dignity and confidence, and (f) inspire their peers and the Filipino people to serve in their communities (move people to action or to bring change in the lives of people in their communities).

There are three (3) major components, namely: Award for Teachers, Award for Soldiers, and Award for Police Officers. A total of ten (10) Outstanding Filipinos will be conferred, composed of four (4) teachers, three (3) soldiers and three (3) police officers.

Nominees who are set to retire must have at least three (3) more years remaining in active service before retirement; ▪ PERFORMANCE EVALUATION - should also have a performance rating of at least Very Satisfactory in the last ten (10) years of his/her career; ▪ CHARACTER RECORD - must be of good moral character; and ▪ POSITION/RANK - must also have attained minimum position/ranks as: 	
Award for Teachers	Elementary or high school teachers must have completed academic requirements for a Master’s Degree, while Higher Education teacher-nominee must have a Doctorate Degree,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ↓ Local Chief Executives (Provincial Governors, City Mayors and Municipal Mayors), ↓ Director supervisor in the AFP/PNP (soldiers/police officers), ↓ School heads, principals and deans (teachers), ↓ Civil society organizations, ↓ NGO leaders, ↓ Church organizations, ↓ TV/radio station manager, or ↓ Print Media Publisher/Editor-in-Chief
Award for Soldiers	AFP commissioned officers (Captain to Colonel) must have a Bachelor’s Degree, while AFP enlisted personnel (Corporal to Chief Master Sergeant) must be at least a high school graduate,	
Award for Police Officers	PNP commissioned officers (Police Inspector to Police Senior Superintendent), while PNP non-commissioned officers (Police Officer 2 to Senior Police Office 4) must have a Bachelor’s Degree	

Nominees must complete the online nomination form accessible through the official Facebook page of the 2018 Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos (facebook.com.mbfi.outstandingfilipinos) and bit.ly/2018OFAwardNomination Forms.


Upon completion of the said online nomination form, which must be signed by the nominator, the nominee shall receive in their email, further instructions on preparing their supporting documents and other important information about the program.

Relative thereto, all Provincial Governors, City Mayors, Municipal Mayors, and other concerned nominators are enjoined to nominate police officers and teachers to the said awards, of which the deadline of submission of nomination form with complete supporting documents will be on March 1, 2018.

Each of the awardees will receive a Metrobank Foundation Outstanding Filipinos Trophy, a Gold Medallion and a cash prize of one million (PhP 1.0 M) pesos during the 56th Anniversary Celebration of Metrobank in September, 2018. The 2018 awardees will also be conferred the title, "2018 Metrobank Foundation Fellows in Outstanding Public Service" and will be given the opportunity to share their best practices and expertise through lectures across the country.
