The Luzon Information and Communications Technology (ICT) Councils of the National ICT Confederation of the Philippines (NICP), in partnership with the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), will be conducting the **2018 Convergence of Luzon ICT Champions Conference and Exhibition (CLICConEx)**, to be held on July 05, 2018 at the Siena College of Taytay, Rizal.

The CLICConEx, which began in 2016, is an annual event supported by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), target leaders of government, business, academe, and organizations that work for innovation and collaboration in promoting inclusive growth in the countryside through ICT development. A major component of this year's conference is the implementation of Digital Cities Program which aims to enhance the delivery of services and the performance of duties and responsibilities by local government units (LGUs) through the effective and efficient utilization of ICT. Said program encourages nationwide participation as this will culminate in the awarding and recognition of LGUs with the most innovative and exemplary utilization of ICT on October 12, 2018.
