RESOLUTION NO. 2020-29-C

September 9, 2020

RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE REQUEST OF COTABATO CITY TO IATF-MEID ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY IN THE SELECTED AREAS OF THE CITY FROM SEPTEMBER 8-22, 2020

WHEREAS, DILG Advisory dated June 22, 2020 which supports the IATF and NTF Memorandum Circular on the Application of the Zoning Containment Strategy for COVID-19 provides that LGUs, through their Local Chief Executives, have the authority to determine and declare zoning classification and lockdown depending on preset parameters, including the existence of suspected, probable, or confirmed COVID-19 case. The authority maybe exercised immediately to ensure timely response, subject to the review and assessment of the RIATF;

WHEREAS, per IATF guidelines, LGUs declaring localized lockdowns shall submit to the RIATF thru the Screening and Validation Committee, their data analytics on lockdowns, as reference by the RIATF in concurring the request of the LGUs;

WHEREAS, all activities or interventions in the type of community quarantine shall be in accordance with the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines issued by the IATF and policies and guidelines issued by the NTF;

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2020, the City Government of Cotabato requested the endorsement of RIATF-EID XII for a “localized lockdown” to the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases for the implementation of immediate containment procedures necessary in order to control the rapid increase of COVID-19 cases;

WHEREAS, in a span of 16 days the Cotabato City Inter-Agency Task Force have recorded more than 26 confirmed cases and the number of confirmed cases are expected to rapidly increase in the following days;

WHEREAS, the Screening and Validation Committee of the RIATF-EID XII convened on September 9, 2020 to assess and validate the requests of the LGU pursuant to RIATF-RTF XII Resolution No. 26-G and recommended for the endorsement of the declarations for “localized lockdown” of LGU Cotabato City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the RIATF-EID XII approved RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE REQUEST OF COTABATO CITY TO IATF-MEID ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY IN THE SELECTED AREAS OF THE CITY FROM SEPTEMBER 8-22, 2020 with the following specifications:

Localized Lockdown of **Cotabato City** on **September 8-22, 2020**, to cover the following areas and shall be placed as Critical Zone:

1. Purok Lawaan, Barangay Bagua Mother;

2. Purok Durian, Barangay Bagua Mother;
3. Purok Duhat, Barangay Bagua Mother;
4. Purok 1, Mabini Street, Barangay Bagua 3;
5. Purok Fisheries B, Barangay Kalanganan Mother;
6. Purok Lushin Chan, Barangay Poblacion 1;
7. Purok Don Cesar, Barangay Poblacion 3;
8. Pantalan Area, Poblacion 5;
9. Purok Bonifacio, Mabini Street, Barangay Poblacion 6;

11. Purok Macapagal, Rosary Heights Mother;
12. Purok 7, Rosary Heights 1;
13. Purok Sampaloc, Barangay Rosary Heights 2;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a regular reassessment on the parameters shall be conducted every seven days or more oftener, as bases for extension or early lifting of the localized lockdown or zoning containment strategy; Spot Mapping and Generation of Contacts shall also be done with the assistance of the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) delineating areas categorized as Critical Zone, Containment Zone, Buffer Zone and Outside Buffer Zone; and the same shall be submitted to the RTF and RIATF XII on CoVID-19;





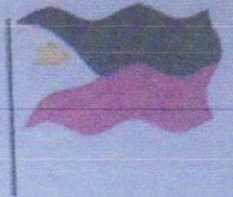

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 375

8 September 2020

**AN ORDER FURTHER AMENDING E.O. 356 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE
COVID CONTAINMENT ORDER**

WHEREAS, In a span of 16 days the Cotabato City Inter Agency Task Force have recorded more than 26 confirmed cases;

WHEREAS, The number of confirmed cases are expected to rapidly rise in the following days;

WHEREAS, Immediate Containment Procedures are necessary in order to control the rapid increase of Covid-19 cases;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ATTY. FRANCES CYNTHIA J. GUIANI-SAYADI, Mayor of Cotabato City, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare the immediate adoption of this Executive Order imposing strict contact tracing and control measures to track down and prevent the spread of Novel Coronavirus Cases:

SECTION 1. Section 26 of E.O. 356 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 26. Contingency Measures. The following areas are suspected to be Critical Zones and may be subject to quarantine upon approval by the Inter-Agency Task Force:

Due to the fast rise of Suspect, Probable, and Confirmed cases in just hours, certain areas may be subject to preventive measures, to promote and protect public health and safety, pending the issuance of an executive order for such purpose.

a. Purok – Each Barangay shall formulate their own containment strategies in accordance with Memorandum Circular No. 13 Series of 2020.

1. Purok Lawaan, Barangay Bagua Mother
2. Purok Durian, Barangay Bagua Mother
3. Purok Duhat, Barangay Bagua Mother
4. Purok 1, Mabini Street Barangay Bagua 3
5. Purok Fisheries B, Barangay Kalanganan Mother
6. Purok Lushin Chan, Barangay Poblacion 1
7. Purok Don Cesar, Barangay Poblacion 3
8. Pantalan Area, Poblacion 5
9. Purok Bonifacio, Mabini Street, Barangay Poblacion 6
10. Purok Datu Siang, Poblacion 7
11. Purok Macapagal, Rosary Heights Mother
12. Purok 7, Rosary Heights 1
13. Purok Sampaloc, Barangay Rosary Heights 2

14. Purok 5, Virgo Subdivision, Barangay Rosary Heights 9
15. Purok Federville, Barangay Rosary Heights 11
16. Purok Adelfa, Barangay Rosary Heights 13
17. Purok Talaynged, Barangay Tamontaka 1
18. Purok Subdivision 2, Barangay Tamontaka 1”

b. Barangays - Barangays subject to quarantine shall narrow down, as far as practicable, specific puroks and only implement their containment strategies in areas identified as critical zones. Identification of such areas shall be made in coordination with the City Health Office and or Barangay Health Emergency Response Team

Each Barangay shall formulate their containment strategies in accordance with Memorandum Circular No. 13 Series of 2020.

20. Barangay Rosary Heights 10
21. Barangay Rosary Heights 12

c. GOVERNMENT OFFICE COMPOUND - The BARMM Government having issued Memorandum Order No. 0529 and Advisory dated September 6, 2020 which declared the temporary closure of the Office of the Chief Minister, the management and control over such Government Office Compound herein declared as critical zone is left to the discretion of the Government of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao.

All persons are advised to avoid entering or passing through these areas.

In the event of the sudden resurgence of cases of Covid-19 calibrated lockdown shall be imposed upon the affected barangay, **portions of such barangay, purok** and such places as may be deemed proper by the Cotabato City Government and/or Regional Inter Agency Task Force.

SECTION 2. Separability Clause. If any of the provisions of this Order is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void or unenforceable, in whole or in part, such provision shall be deemed deleted from this Order but the remaining provisions thereof shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. Repealing Clause. All Orders and issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked, repealed, revised or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect on September 8, 2020 and shall remain effective unless sooner revoked, modified or repealed accordingly.

RESOLUTION CONCURRENCE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGIES IN THE SELECTED AREAS OF THE MUNICIPALITIES OF SURALLAH, MIDSAYAP AND MAASIM, AND CITY OF KORONADAL OF THIS REGION

WHEREAS, DILG Advisory dated June 22, 2020 which supports the IATF and NTF Memorandum Circular on the Application of the Zoning Containment Strategy for COVID-19 provides that LGUs, through their Local Chief Executives, have the authority to determine and declare zoning classification and lockdown depending on preset parameters, including the existence of suspected, probable, or confirmed COVID-19 case. The authority maybe exercised immediately to ensure timely response, subject to the review and assessment of the RIATF;

WHEREAS, per IATF guidelines, LGUs declaring localized lockdowns shall submit to the RIATF thru the Screening and Validation Committee, their data analytics on lockdowns, as reference by the RIATF in concurring the request of the LGUs;

WHEREAS, all activities or interventions in the type of community quarantine shall be in accordance with the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines issued by the IATF and policies and guidelines issued by the NTF;

WHEREAS, on September 7 and 8, 2020, there are 4 Local Government Units in Region XII, which requested the concurrence of the RIATF-EID XII for a “localized lockdown” namely: the Municipality of Surallah, City of Koronadal, both from the Province of South Cotabato, Municipality of Midsayap, Province of Cotabato, and Municipality of Maasim, Province of Sarangani;

WHEREAS, recently, the Municipality of Surallah and City of Koronadal, both from the Province of South Cotabato, Municipality of Midsayap, Province of Cotabato, and Municipality of Maasim, Province of Sarangani recorded new active cases – 3, 4, 2 and 2, respectively. These individuals were found to be mobile, had close-contacts to other confirmed cases, and with travel history to high risk areas prior to the onset of symptoms or illness and release of RT-PCR result;

WHEREAS, the Screening and Validation Committee of the RIATF convened on September 8, 2020 to assess and validate the requests of the three (3) LGUs pursuant to RIATF-RTF Resolution No. 26-G and recommended for the concurrence of the Declarations for localized lockdown of the LGUs of Surallah, City of Koronadal, Midsayap, and Maasim;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the RIATF-EID XII approved RESOLUTION CONCURRENCE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ZONING CONTAINMENT

STRATEGIES IN THE SELECTED AREAS OF THE MUNICIPALITIES OF SURALLAH, MIDSAYAP AND MAASIM, AND CITY OF KORONADAL OF THIS REGION with the following specifications:

- A. Localized Lockdown of **Surallah, South Cotabato** on **September 3-17, 2020**, to cover the following areas:
- *Compound of the confirmed COVID-19 case located at Purok 4, Barangay Centrala as Critical Zone;*
 - *Area in front of Centralla Satellite Market at Barangay Centrala as Containment Zone;*
 - *The rest of Purok 4, Barangay Centrala as Buffer Zone; and*
 - *The rest of Barangay Centrala as Outside Buffer Zone*
- B. Localized Lockdown in **City of Koronadal, South Cotabato** on **September 3-17, 2020**, to cover the following areas:
- *Purok Maligaya, Morrow Street, Barangay Zone I (Purok Lockdown);*
 - *Agreda Phase 3, Barangay Sta. Cruz (Block Containment);*
 - *San Antonio Subdivision Phase 4, Barangay Sta. Cruz (House Containment);*
 - *Purok Ramos, Barangay Sta. Cruz (House Containment);*
 - *Purok Hillside, Barangay Sta. Cruz (Cluster Containment);*
 - *Purok Maunlad, Barangay Saravia (Purok Lockdown); and*
 - *Purok Pagkakaisa, Urban, Barangay San Isidro (Purok Lockdown)*
- C. Localized Lockdown of **Midsayap, Province of Cotabato** on **September 3-17, 2020**, to cover the following area:
- *Burgos Street, Barangay Poblacion 1 and 6*
- D. Localized Lockdown of **Maasim, Province of Sarangani** on **September 2-16, 2020**, to cover the following areas:
- *Portion of Purok 5, Barangay Poblacion as Critical Zone;*
 - *Remaining portion of Purok 5, and Purok 4, Barangay Poblacion as Containment Zone;*
 - *Puroks 2 and 3, Barangay Poblacion as Buffer Zone; and*
 - *The rest the puroks of the barangay and its adjacent areas shall be categorized as Outside Buffer Zone*

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a regular reassessment on the parameters shall be conducted every seven days or more oftener, as bases for extension or early lifting of the localized lockdown or zoning containment strategy; Spot Mapping and Generation of Cases shall also be done with the assistance of the Municipal/City Planning and Development Office (M/CPDO) delineating areas categorized as Critical Zone, Containment Zone, Buffer Zone and Outside Buffer Zone; and the same shall be submitted to the RTF and RIATF XII on CoVID-19;




