TO : ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNORS, CITY MAYORS, MUNICIPAL MAYORS, THE ARMM REGIONAL GOVERNOR, DILG REGIONAL DIRECTORS, AND OTHERS CONCERNED

SUBJECT : YOUTH ENVIRONMENTAL SUMMIT 2016

Pursuant to AD Ref Resolution No. 18, series of 2016, of the National Youth Commission, Office of the President, the conduct of a Youth Environment Summit (YES) is endorsed, to be held on April 11-13, 2016 at Teacher's Camp, Baguio City, through the Alliance for Green Philippines Inc.

The summit aims to foster a new generation of environmental and sustainability leaders, provide a platform for discussion among experts on environment, energy and food security, and youth leaders from all over the Philippines.

Relative thereto, the Department hereby enjoins LGUs to participate by sending selected young officers and employees, preferably those engaged in disaster preparedness, environment protection and community development and outreach, on official business.

Travelling expenses and a registration fee may be authorized chargeable against local funds subject to the availability thereof and to all pertinent laws, rules and regulations provided that the travelling expenses and registration fee shall not be charged against the 20% component of the Internal Revenue Allotment or from whatever source that may prejudice on-going poverty alleviation efforts.
