INVITATION TO THE CENTRAL BUSINESS PORTAL

(CBP) PHASE 1 NATIONAL LAUNCH

The Anti-Red Tape Authority, in partnership with the Department of the Interior and Local Government and other national government agencies, will be conducting an activity titled "Central Business Portal (CBP) Phase 1 National Launch" on January 28, 2021 at 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM. The Central Business Portal Phase 1 aims to integrate the processes of the pilot national government agencies and local government units involved in the processing of the primary and secondary registration of new corporations.

The CBP Phase 1 will cover the following:

- 1. Unified Application Form for agencies
- Online Registration with SEC
- 3. Online Registration with BIR
- 4. Online Generation of TIN for BIR, and Employer Numbers for SSS, PhilHealth, Pag-IBIG
- 5. Interface with BIR ePayment channels
- 6. Online Generation of BIR Certificate of Registration
- 7. Unified Employee Reporting Module for SSS, PhilHealth, Pag-IBIG
- 8. Issuance of Secondary license featuring FDA's License to Operate for Center for Drugs
- 9. Interface with the Quezon City Business Permitting System
- 10. Redirection to the Paranaque City Business Permitting System
- 11. Interface with the 16 pilot LGUs with eBPLS

The CBP launching will gather accounting firms, law firms, business organizations, local and foreign chambers, business sectors, other government agencies and stakeholders who are direct users and/or beneficiaries of this project.

All DILG Regional and Field Offices, and Local Chief Executives are cordially invited to participate in this activity. The launching may be watched through the Official Facebook Page of Anti-Red Tape Authority.
