RESOLUTION NO. 2022-07 January 12, 2022

RESOLUTION ADOPTING CAAP MEMORANDUM NO. 001-2022 DATED JANUARY 11, 2022 FOR DISSEMINATION BY LGUS TO THEIR RESPECTIVE CONSTITUENTS

- **WHEREAS,** Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;
- WHEREAS, on September 10, 2021, the President issued Proclamation No. 1218 series of 2021, further extending the period of the State of Calamity throughout the Philippines until September 12, 2022, unless earlier lifted as circumstances may warrant or extended due to the public's failure to comply with minimum health protocols and sudden spike of new COVID-19 cases in the country;
- WHEREAS, during the Joint Meeting of the RIATF-EID XII and RTF Against COVID-19 XII on January 12, 2022, the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) General Santos City Airport Manager, Joel G. Javina presented the CAAP Airport Memorandum No. 001-2022 dated January 11, 2022, re: No Vaccination, No Entry Policy (Revised);
- **WHEREAS,** the said Airport Memorandum stipulates that passengers, visitors, guests and/or clients need to present their Vaccination Card or Vaccination Certificate



at all times, in all access gates within the airport. Partially vaccinated individuals shall present a valid RT-PCR result taken within 72 hours prior to arrival to General Santos City Airport. Airport/Airlines Employees including transport vehicles whether public or private-owned must display their vaccination card or vaccination certificates, otherwise they cannot enter the premises of the airport;

- WHEREAS, due to the alarming cases of the Omicron Variant in the National Capital Region (NCS), a heightened alert at the General Santos City Airport is implemented to prevent the entry of the highly transmissible Omicron and considering that passengers of inbound flights originate from Cebu or Manila;
- NOW THEREFORE, on motion of RD Servillano Santiago Lorenzo III of DOJ-PAO XII and seconded by ARD Flora Gabunales of DTI XII; BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to REQUEST THE PROVINCIAL LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS OF REGION XII TO CONSIDER THE ESTABLISHMENT OF OXYGEN-GENERATING PLANTS FOR BIG HOSPITALS IN THEIR AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (AOR).
- **RESOLVED FURTHER,** that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the IATF-EID, NTF COVID-19, and members of the RIATF-EID XII and RTF-COVID-19 XII for their information and support. Same Resolution will also be forwarded to all Local Government Units of Region XII for their information and massive dissemination.
